JOB TITLE: Seniors' Cricket Coach, Midland Guildford Cricket Club

REPORTS TO: Head of Coaching, Midland Guildford Cricket Club

SKILLS REQUIRED:

- HPCA (Level 3) coach accreditation – but minimum RCA (Level 2) accreditation essential
- Proven high level communication skills and commitment to instil, further develop, and maintain the "We Are Midland Guildford" ethos across Cricket Operations including all coaches and players, including team leaders, within the Club, and in conjunction with the Head of Coaching, to lead from the front in relation to this, and ensure all other Club coaches and coaching specialists do likewise
- Very good planning and programming capabilities
- Highly motivated and enthusiastic with ability to motivate and engage players with a commitment to teamwork, and to the personal & cricket development of all players throughout all levels at the Club
- Strong cricket technical and strategic skills based upon a good understanding of the game, relevant playing rules and vision for the evolution of the game at Premier Cricket level

MAIN DUTIES:

- Assist the Head of Coaching to plan the Club's pre-season and in-season training programmes with identified training phases that are recognised and deliverable by all appointed coaching staff
- Ensure conduct of pre-season and in-season training/development programmes (skills, strategy and physical preparation) in consultation with all Club appointed coaches, cricket specialists and players
- Promote alignment across the Club of seniors, colts, and juniors as a single cohesive unit, and continually improving community of Midland Guildford cricketers
- Assist, in consultation with the Head of Coaching and other appointed coaches, the strategy for player analysis across all levels of the Club
- Continuing consultation with the Head of Coaching and all other coaches on all relevant matters
- Assist with team selections, if requested
- Attendance, as required, at WACA High Performance workshops and other coaching training in line with WACA Premier Cricket grant requirements
- Assist facilitation and submission of talent portal assessments and fitness testing data as part of the WACA Premier Cricket grant requirements
- Active attendance across all grades, in consultation with the Head of Coaching and other appointed coaches, at in-season matches to support and mentor the development of all players
- Mandatory attendance at all Club functions – this includes, but is not limited to, players' teas, selection nights (if separately occurring), and social events
