CLOTHING PROCUREMENT POLICY

This Policy intends to provide clarity on the Official Clothing for the Club and the process for how new material is developed and released.

This Policy refers to the Clothing Guidelines for Players and Officials and the Sponsorship Policy, which can be found on the club website.

OFFICIAL AUTHORISED CLOTHING TYPES

The Committee manages the arrangements and procurement of all clothing and merchandise on behalf of the Club.

A recent competitive procurement process was undertaken with multiple providers relating to Official Off Field Clothing Attire for the Club. At the conclusion of that process, Slater Gartrell Sports were invited to extend their Exclusive Provider arrangements to include Off-field clothing until August 2026, with the option to extend by mutual agreement.

The Club's Official Authorised clothing is broken into two types -

NON-APPROVED OR NON-OFFICIAL CLOTHING

The Club controls the use of our logo and brand, with unofficial clothing forbidden. Players, Officials and members who wear unofficial clothing may face disciplinary action.

PROCESS FOR RELEASE OF NEW MATERIAL

The Committee is keen to ensure officials, players and supporters continue to have access to quality clothing and merchandise that meets their ongoing and changing needs.

This is carefully balanced to reduce costs for our members, maintain our strong sponsorship support whilst providing the up to date needs of our members.

All of this must be managed in a responsible manner that ensures the Club's brand value is maintained and the Club is represented to the highest standard.

The intent of the process is to make it clear to both providers and members to how new material can be introduced.

This process may be altered at any time by agreement of the Committee, however the standard protocol will be as follows:

On Field, Training and Official Off field Official Clothing

- Must be in line with WACA requirements
- Official Sponsors to be recognized in line with Sponsorship Policy
- Officials and Players are encouraged to suggest updates for Committee consideration annually, by the end of May each year or as invited by the Committee
- The Committee will seek player representation and contribution in items and designs to be released, however the Committee's decision will be final in respect to all Official clothing released.

Process


The Committee is keen to ensure all players have input into the range of clothing required, particularly the Off Field attire.

For Off Field clothing, a new process has been developed in conjunction with our Exclusive Provider, Slater Gartrell Sports that includes the Exclusive Provider contributing a portion of each sale back to the Club. The process is inclusive to ensure male, female, junior and senior representation is encouraged in design and items to be released.
