## **DEFINITIONS**

**On Field Playing** – Attire approved by the Club to be worn whilst playing either on the field, or during a match (including off field whilst at the ground representing the Club).

Includes all material associated with game day, including but not limited to playing shirts, pants, hats, jumpers, tracksuits and helmet covers. Officials (Coaches, Team Managers) may also wear on field training attire on game day.

**On Field Training** – Attire approved by the Club to be worn whilst training.

Includes all material associated with training, including but not limited to training shirts, shorts, hats, jumpers, tracksuits and helmet covers.

**Off Field Official** – Attire approved by the Club to be worn off field, including sponsors polo shirts and official off field range. Includes but not limited to jumpers, hats, shorts, shirts – all clothing that has been approved by the Club.

**Players** – All players representing the Club in a playing capacity.

**Officials** – All Coaches, Assistant Coaches, Team Managers and others representing the Club in an Official capacity (including Committee).

## **NON-APPROVED OR NON-OFFICIAL CLOTHING**

The Club controls the use of our logo and brand, with unofficial clothing forbidden.

Players, Officials and members who wear unofficial clothing may face disciplinary action.

## **BREACHING OF THIS POLICY**

The Club expects all members to comply with the clothing policy. Committee will consider all breaches and determine appropriate action/s to resolve non-compliance events

There may be occasions where the Guidelines cannot be followed and, in those circumstances, please contact your Team Manager as soon as possible to discuss.

### **Training Attire**

Players and Officials are to wear Official On field Training attire as directed by the Club. Any questions should be discussed with the Team Manager.

Training uniform includes official training shirts, shorts, hats, jumpers, tracksuits, helmet covers).

### **Game Day**

Players and Officials are permitted to wear the following attire on game day:

<b>Event</b>	<b>Attire Required</b>
<b>Arriving / Departing Venue</b>	Players and Officials may wear Official Off Field attire or On Field Training Attire (ie no creams or playing kit, players should be changed into either their training kit, Club polo or official Off Field Attire to and from the playing venue)
<b>Warm up</b>	Players must wear On Field Training Attire. Officials may wear On Field Training or Off Field Official Attire during the warm ups.
<b>During Play</b>	Players must wear On Field Playing Attire when on the field and may wear On Field Training Attire or Off Field Official Attire whilst off the ground.  Officials may wear On Field Training or Off Field Official Attire.
<b>Clubrooms Post Game</b>	Players may wear On Field Training, On Field Playing or Off Field Official Attire at the conclusion of play.

### **Club Presentations**

Whilst it is preferred the Club Polo is worn where possible, Players and Officials may wear Official Off Field Attire or On Field Training Attire to presentations, like players tea or awards.

### **Official Events and Representing the Club**

When an Official or Player is representing the Club, unless otherwise stipulated they are required to wear Official Off Field Clothing that includes the Club logo (like the Club Polo) and be neat and tidy at all times.

### **Off Field – Non-Official**

Players and officials often support our other Club teams, or their own team when they are not playing which is great. There is no requirement for players to wear any official clothing during these periods, however, are encouraged to consider representing the club by wearing the Official Off Field Attire.
